Thank you for meeting with me last week. I enjoyed being able to talk with you regarding your child. If you have any further questions, please do not hesitate to ask.

We have completed our in-class portion of the Native American projects. Most of the students finished their rough draft in class. If they didn't, I sent you an email advising I need to see their rough draft by Wednesday. I did not review their rough draft for accuracy, spelling, etc. Please review the report requirements, and review their rough draft to ensure they have everything. Please also proofread their rough draft and have them make any corrections. I sent home the final copy packet today. They are to use the white construction paper as the cover. On the cover, they are to write the name of their tribe, their name, my name, and date. They should either draw pictures or glue/tape internet pictures. The illustration page can be hand-drawn or pictures from the internet, **but they must have captions**. I sent home another copy of the format for the Bibliography (remember they must have three sources). Thank you for helping your child with their research report. They did a great job taking notes and making sentences out of their notes. Please let me know if you have any questions. I am here to help!

Our class will be going to the Christmas Boutique on Wednesday, 11/30. The students love to buy you and other loved ones Christmas presents at the boutique. If you would like them to participate, please be sure to send money (cash or check payable to St. Edward School) and a list of the people they are to buy for and a budget to spend on each person.
