I am extremely pleased with the K-1 student's preparations for our Class Liturgy for Wednesday. Thank you parents for all the practice time you put in to make them shine! The objective of this week's Religion sessions is to help the children understand that as life changes, they can respond with loving care.

The children need to recognize the capital and lower case letters of all letters covered thus far. They also need to know the sound of each letter and **write the capital and lowercase letter** when given its sound!

Our Math objective this week is to work on subtraction and addition problems, reading the signs (+ & -) to know which procedure to perform.

Center Activities this week will focus on activities having to do with the ocean. We are working on a Swimmy wash, Aquarium, Rainbow Fish wind sock, and a listening/writing paper!
